GENERAL INFORMATION

LOCATION: The workshop will be held from August 6-12, 2007 on the campus of Johnson State College in Johnson, Vermont, located to nearby resorts of Stowe and Smugglers' Notch. The campus can be reached by interstate highways and secondary highways. The closest city, Burlington, has a large national airport, and Greyhound bus station, and AMTRAK rail station.

PROGRAM COSTS: If paid in full before July 20th, 2007, TUITION ONLY package of **\$675USD** includes the complete week of classes, master classes, informal workshops, and evening concerts. DOUBLE OCCUPANCY package - **\$995 USD** and SINGLE OCCUPANCY package – **\$1080USD** comprises tuition, three meals per day and lodging for the week. In addition, 1, 2, 3, and 4-day packages are also available upon request.

PRE-REGISTRATION DEADLINE: All fully completed applications must be received by **JULY 20TH 2007** to ensure your place. All applications **MUST** be accompanied by a non-refundable 350\$ (US) deposit or payment in full AND MAILED TO: **c/o Adventure Travel, Box 889 Lawton, OK 73502 U.S.A**

AGE REQUIREMENTS: Any participant who is **14 YEARS AND UNDER** must come accompanied by an adult in order to participate in the program. The price for a 14 year and under participant and the accompanying adult will be **\$1,365USD** which includes tuition, food and lodging for both youth and adult.

HOUSING: Residence Halls are located next to Johnson State College's Dibden Theatre. Residence Halls are equipped with pay phones and laundry facilities. **Normal college regulations are in force** KoSA reserves the right to dismiss any participant who does not conform to these practical regulations.

MEALS: Participants who are registered under single or double occupancy packages will be dining along with the KoSA faculty in the residence food hall. TUITION ONLY participants may purchase meals on an individual basis (paying per meal).

KoSA FESTIVAL CONCERTS: During the week, there will be many special evening concerts which will be open to the general public and which will feature the instructing faculty and special guests. The concerts will be provided to full-week participants at no extra charge. On Friday night, participants will have the chance to shine in their very own Participant Concert. Saturday night will be the GRAND FINALE GALA CONCERT featuring the KoSA Artist Faculty. There will be a small cover charge for all evening concerts (\$10). *******College Credit:** KoSA participants may obtain one (1) undergraduate or graduate credit at a cost of \$165USD if they enroll for the FULL week. Payment in full (checks made out to "KoSA Communications") for credit will be due at the on-site registration.

KoSA SPECIAL ACCOMODATION FOR MUSIC EDUCATORS : KoSA will **credit** the tuition portion of the KoSA program (**\$675USD**) to any full-time music educator or adult private percussion instructor enrolling a minimum of ten (10) or more students for the full week. The students' application forms and deposits must be sent along with the instructor's application in one envelope.
