- Intro to Rhythm, Ages 4-6, Cost \$130 (8 weeks)**  
 A brand new class developed for musical children and their parents. Kids will have fun with percussion while learning the basics of rhythm.
- Band Match (Play in an Electric Band), 10 weeks, cost \$350**  
 Bass, drums, guitar, keyboards, singers, etc. in jazz, rock, fusion, pop. Participants will learn to play in a combo and will meet with a coach weekly.
- Steel Pan, Open to All, cost \$250**  
 Learn to play in a steel drum ensemble with veteran drummer James Andrews, the musician who introduced Canada to steel pan music.
- Popular Cuban Percussion, Level 1 and Level 2, cost \$250**  
 Learn popular Cuban rhythms played on conga, timbales, bongos, etc.
- Traditional Cuban Rhythms, Open to All, cost \$250**  
 Explore traditional Cuban music including Santiago, rumba, conga franceisa, Cuban carnival music and more.
- Brazilian Batucada, Open to All, cost \$250**  
 Learn traditional Brazilian rhythms and how they apply on drumset.
- Classical Percussion, Level 1 & 2, cost \$250**  
 Participants will be playing and learning ensemble repertoire (snare, marimba, bass drum, multiple percussion, etc.)

- **African Drumming, Level 1 and Level 2, cost \$250**  
For lovers of African drumming, traditional West African rhythms on djembe and dun dun will be explored.
- **Indian Rhythms, Open to All, cost \$250**  
Traditional Indian rhythms will be explained hands-on and participants learn to play them on drumset and Western percussion instruments.
- **Studio and Small Percussion (studio & pop percussion), Open to All, cost \$250**  
Learn to play groove-oriented rhythms using triangle, kabasa, conga, shakers, and how to compliment the drummer and music whether live or in the studio.
- **Guitar Ensemble, Ages 12-15, cost \$250**  
Learn and improve on basic guitar skills by playing in a motivating group environment.
- **Bucket Drumming, Open to All, cost \$250**  
Creative music making using such basic tools as buckets and other street musical instruments.
