

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Q: Do you take absolute beginners?**

A: No. We ask participants to have at least 2 years of experience on their instrument. Although all campers receive professional coaching, teaching will actually be focused on ensemble playing and not individual instruction. *(Note: Private instrument lessons are available through KoSA Academy year-round.) ### **Q: Regarding age requirements, does my child really have to be 10 to attend?**

A: If your child turns 10 by June 1st of the current year, they may attend.

### **Q: How are bands grouped?**

A: Bands are grouped by age, experience level and also by style of music. We ask each camper to list three favorite bands when enrolling to determine style.

### **Q: What are camp hours?**

A: Camp runs from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Drop off is between 8:30 a.m. to 9 a.m. Pick-up is from 4:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. After 4:30 we must assess a late fee of \$5.00 for the first 15 minutes and an additional \$1.00 per minute afterwards. If you find that 4:30 p.m. is not feasibly possible then we offer extended pick-up hours (until 6 p.m.) for an additional \$50 per week per child.

### **Q: How much does the camp cost per week?**

A: \$425 per week. This includes use of our state-of-the art air-conditioned facility, concert hall, practice rooms and certain provided equipment.

### **Q: Is lunch included?**

A: No. Parents must provide lunch, snacks, and beverages. Students will not be allowed to go to restaurants for lunch or snacks during camp hours.
